



WATERING INSTRUCTIONS

Watering your rented Pot Plants and/or Hedges is very important, to ensure they look their best during your property inspections, and are returned to us in good condition.

- Each Hedge needs two full 9L laundry buckets of water *twice a week*.



Twice a week

- Other pot plants eg. Ficus, Gardenia, outdoor Palms each need a minimum of one full 9L laundry bucket of water *twice a week*.



Twice a week

- Agaves or Yuccas - each need only one full 9L laundry bucket per week.



Once a week

- Indoor plants eg. Palms & Peace Lilys need only 1.5L of water *after 2.5 weeks*. Note: pots are sealed.



In the event of a heavy rain fall watering can be delayed for *one day* only.



**** TIP ****

Outdoor pots and troughs will drain clear water, so best not to water just before an inspection!

Sadly, the Conifer Hedge shown below is not able to be saved. The client assured us "the heat got it", however the same plants in our nursery had no signs of heat stress.
